All staff who conduct assessments <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Some examples include: Therapists, Case Managers, RNs, Clinical Program Directors, Psychs, MDs 6.5 CEUs offered through APA and NASW 	6.5 hours	Within 90 days of hire and every 3 years after
